

Catch Up Funding – 2015 / 16

In the year 2015/16 a total of 19 pupils came to Ian Ramsey below level 4 in their Maths KS2 assessment. The total for English was 20 pupils. 'Catch Up' funding was used to strategically deploy HLTAs and TAs for bespoke, in-class support or, where appropriate, withdrawal as individuals or as small groups. The academy also bought in to the Accelerated Reading Programme.

The results of their progress are recorded below:

Maths (Numeracy) - 84% achieved level 4 in year 7

12/19 level 3 on entry - **All 12 achieved level 4** during the academic year 15/16

7/19 level 2 on entry - **4 of the 7 achieved level 4** during 15/16.

Of the remaining 3, 1 has made 1 whole level's progress and 2 have made 2 sublevels' progress.

English (Literacy) - 65% achieved level 4 in year 7

16/20 level 3 on entry - **13/16 achieved level 4** during the academic year 15/16

4/20 level 2 on entry - **3 have made 2 sublevels' progress** - the 4th pupil has since left the school.

Reading Age/Spelling Age

Pupils working on literacy beyond the traditional curriculum improved their reading ages by an average of 24 months and spelling age by 20 months following one-to-one intervention.

Of note were 3 pupils whose reading age increased by 50+ months
