Dear Parent/Carer,

Uniform 2018

As you will be aware, by now, we are making some improvements to our uniform. I feel the need to write to you to clarify what is expected of pupils' uniforms from September 2018.

Girls who are currently in years 7-10, who wish to wear a skirt next year, must purchase the new style of skirt from Elizabeth's Embroidery. This is, of course, optional as grey trousers may be worn as an alternative. The shirt/tie and blazer remain the same for all year groups.

There are alternative choices for girls from years 7-11, which are on the price list available on our website. These include a pinafore dress, open neck, academy blouse and cardigan. These are entirely optional but blazers are still expected to be worn by all girls.

There are no changes to the boy's uniform.

Both boys and girls PE kit for all year groups is in the process of changing. All are expected to wear the new polo shirt (except current year 10 pupils), available from Elizabeth's Embroidery, which is a high quality, quick drying fabric that requires no ironing. Current PE shorts, socks and rugby shirts can be worn until September 2019, when we would expect all pupils to have the new socks/shorts and rugby tops. Year 6 pupils arriving in September are all expected to wear the new kit.

Again, there is a variety of choice within PE for both tops and bottoms: e.g. skorts, jackets, leggings etc. These are entirely optional and prices are, again, available on the website and can be purchased through Elizabeth's Embroidery.

There will be a number of 'pop up' shops organised by Elizabeth's Embroidery on the following dates and discounts are being offered for advance orders. You will of course still be able to make purchases at any time from their main shop.

31 st May from 12.00 – 2.00	15% discount (May '18)
15 th and 29 th June from 3.45 – 5.30	10% discount (June '18)
5 th and 18 th July from 3.45 – 5.30	5% discount (July '18)
