Use the computer that has been provided for you. ● Follow sanitisation measures (i.e. immediately wash hands upon entering the school building, wash your hands after using the toilet, wash your hands before and after consuming food/drink at break/lunchtime, use the provided hand sanitiser). ● When in classrooms and the Dining Hall, remain in your seat at all times, unless a member of staff has given you permission to move around.
